## About the new ticketless parking system

How does ticketless parking work?	The smart license plate recognition technology eliminates the need for a physical car park ticket or access card, allowing for a contactless entry and exit experience.  When you enter the car park, the automatic license plate recognition camera will read your license plate and automatically raise the boom gate.  To access the new ticketless system, you will need to pre-register your car details via the multiScanhub online portal.  When exiting, the system will recognise your pre-registered vehicle and link you to the relevant parking rate for your user group, if applicable.  So, no more scrambling your bag, wallet or pockets to find your car park access card!	
How will it differ from my current parking experience?	ou will no longer need your car park access card to access and exit the both Bank Car Park. Simply enter and exit the car park and your license ate will be recognised in our parking system. The boom gate will then utomatically open.  In though we are going ticketless, our friendly and helpful Car Park team ill still be available to help should you require further assistance. How do I register my vehicle?	<ul> <li>You will receive an email from multiScanhub inviting you to register via the online portal.</li> <li>Follow the provided instructions to access the portal.</li> <li>Register using the relevant user parking group.</li> <li>Fill in your details and vehicle information.</li> <li>Optionally, provide debit credit card details for payments.</li> <li>Once successfully registered, you'll receive a confirmation email from multiScanhub.</li> </ul>

What happens if I don't register my	If you don't pre-register your vehicle details, you will need to use your car park access card to enter and exit the car park.			
vehicle?	Pre-registering your vehicle offers a seamless entry and exit with the gates automatically opening, eliminating the need for a physical car park access card and providing a more convenient parking experience.			
	Additionally, if the car park is full, the new boom gate located at the top of the ramp will open automatically only for registered vehicles.			
Can I access the car park when full?	Yes, but when the car park is full, the boom gate at the top of the car park entry ramps will be lowered.			
	If your details are registered via the Car Park portal, the boom gate will open automatically for you.			
	If you are still using a car park access card, you will need to swipe it at the entry machine for access.
