



Weekly update: 30 September 2021

Dear residents

It has been a busy month of festivities at South Bank with Brisbane Festival, we hope you were able to enjoy some of the activities. Please find below this week's update.

Maintenance update

Riverside Green and River Quay turf regeneration works

City Parklands Services will also be undertaking turf regeneration works to allow the grass to recover following Brisbane Festival. The below areas will be barricaded off:

- Riverside Green: Wednesday 29 September until Monday 8 November
- River Quay Green: Tuesday 19 October until Friday 19 November

Small sections of the turf may require longer to recover and could be barricaded off for an extended period. No access to the barricaded areas will be allowed. The turf will be inspected this week to determine the length of recovery time required. This may be less or more than indicated above.

Please note the information is subject to change and we will notify in future updates of changes to timings.

River Quay Green tree planting

This week City Parklands Services will replace three new trees at River Quay Green. A small area will be barricaded off while the works take place.

An arborist report was commissioned to assess the declining health of three juvenile trees located at River Quay. The report recommended removal and replacement consistent with the original species selection. The dead trees will be removed using a chainsaw, the remaining stumps and root balls will be removed using a small excavator to ensure the site is well prepared for the new plantings.

Queensland Rail works at South Bank train station

Queensland Rail is upgrading platform 1 at South Bank station to improve accessibility for customers and better connect with the adjacent Southpoint development.

Features of the platform 1 upgrade include:

- a full-length raised platform
- platform seating and shelters that cover the majority of the platform and access ramp
- upgraded security cameras and lighting at assisted boarding points
- new wayfinding and platform signage.
